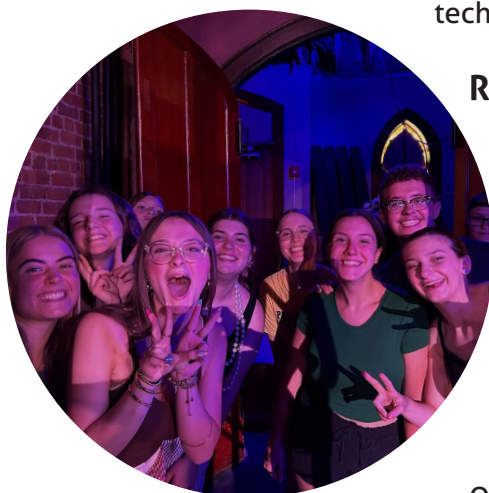
ABOUT SPRINGVILLE CENTER FOR THE ARTS



Springville Center for the Arts is a rural multi-arts center in Springville, New York that serves as the cultural hub for the region. We offer a wide range of programs including concerts, theater productions, gallery exhibits, workshops, summer programs for children, and large-scale community events. SCA's mission is to build a culture of appreciation for the arts and foster creative inspiration through diverse opportunities for artistic engagement.

WHAT YOU'LL DO

- **Events:** Assist with large-scale multi-arts events like the annual Art Crawl. Set up, tear down, and facilitate activity tents within the event.
- **Perform:** Fully produce and perform a children's play for elementary schools in the area.
- **Theater Productions:** Produce and direct 1-2 junior musicals with 25 to 30 elementary students (Lil' SLAM) and a full-scale musical with local high school and college students (SLAM); schedule and run musical rehearsals; create and build sets for theater productions
- **Summer Camps:** Develop lesson plans and teach summer workshops for kids grades PreK through 12. Examples include: playwriting, creative movement, improvisation, music, vocal technique, or technical production.



REQUIREMENTS

- Be an undergraduate student in a theater, technical theater, music education, dance, or similar program
- Ability to perform for and with children
- Comfort teaching, directing, and leading children in a workshop or production setting
- Intrinsic motivation with a strong passion for the arts
- Collaborative skills and ability to work alongside fellow interns, SCA staff members, and the community
- Open mindedness and willingness to learn

INTERN LIFE & BENEFITS

- This is a full-time internship with a weekly stipend of \$250 with housing included.
- The internship begins the last week of May and ends the second week of August.
- You will be living with other theater and visual arts interns in a large house located directly next to the Center, only a block from Main Street. The area is extremely walkable, with restaurants, coffee shops, library, movie theater, parks, and shops all located within a couple blocks. Usually a couple interns have a car and can carpool when necessary. We also have bicycles for intern use.
